

## Instant Blog and Ping Toolbar Overview



### 1. Account Settings:

Click to Enter Your Blog Account Settings and Choose Project

### 2. Page Settings:

Clicking this button brings up a window split into 2 sections  
Page Settings and Posting Settings

**Page Settings-** Choose project working with

- Choose the Number of pages you wish to post at one time
- Choose the Interval time between the next posting
- Choose Description, Random or Unique Tags  
Text for Body of Message
- Choose if you want to use Proxy ( must be valid)

**Posting Settings** – Here is your Pinging Settings, Choose from Yahoo and Pingomatic or do both then But your Blog URL in and Click ADD

**3. Blog and Ping:** - Select Project your working with then..

This is where you give it the Website you wish to post to your Blog  
Choices are

- Add from Url ( Add Main Homepage Url to Crawl all Pages)
- Add from txt file ( Add Urls from Text File)
- Add Url ( individual from one site or many sites)
- Save URLS ( once a site is crawled you can save list for later)



## How to use Instant Blog and Ping Overview

1. Create a Free Blog account at [www.blogger.com](http://www.blogger.com) and Setup Settings
2. Open Instant Blog and Ping Program from the Shortcut on your Desktop or from Start > Program Files > Instant Blog and Ping
3. Click on the first button called FILE then click Create New Project, give it a name and save next click BUTTON 1, select project " Account Settings" and Fill in your Blog account Url, username and password from Blogger.com – Click Save

Alternatively if your using Blogger.com..select wordpress and fill it with your Wordpress Blog URL, username and password that you use to login. ( only fill this in if you wish to use your wordpress blog instead of blogger.com

4. Click on the Second button called " Page Settings" and under the first tab Choose number of pages to post, time interval in mins in between posts, select description, random or unqie tags for the text you want it to post and select proxy if you want to or leave it and click save.
5. Next under posting settings tab put in your main Blog Homepage Url and select either Yahoo or Pingomatic or both. Hit Add and it should place your blog url in front of it. Then press Save and Close

6. Click on the Third Button called “ Blog and Ping” here you enter in your URL or URLs and click SHOW URLs to add them to the bottom section or to crawl in the pages to the bottom section. Once they are all in.
7. Click Start, Minimize the program and Go about your Day! Or Start another project by going to FILE>New Project.. but make sure you have another blog account and website to spider, this way you can have Multiple Sites spidered faster automatically. Pages will begin to post to your blog and pinging will occur.




Ok That's it for Settings.. Now in the top right hand corner of your BLOGGER account you should see this

Ok now Copy the URL you see in the ADDRESS BAR ( Screenshot Below) you need this for the software 1<sup>st</sup> screen " Account Settings"





Then Save and Close ( Screenshot Below)




## Starting a Project

Ok When you first open up blog and ping you will see this screen to get started just click on FILE and a drop down will appear with options

CREATE PROJECT


DELETE PROJECT

CLICK on CREATE PROJECT


You will then see a screen to type the name of your project, give it a name and hit create



Ok next you begin with the large buttons starting with Accounts which is the 1<sup>st</sup> button

## ACCOUNT SETTINGS – STEP 1 – BUTTON 1 - BLOG INFO

When you click on the first button you will see this window minus what I have filled in as that is just to show you what you would put in their ( Yours will be empty to start with) You select your project from the drop down then Fill yours In Hit SAVE and the window will close


Your Blog Url can be found as soon as you log into Blogger.com similar to Below

## PAGE SETTINGS – STEP 2 - BUTTON 2

The Next Step after filling in Account settings is to click on BUTTON 2 and you will see a screen like this ( Screenshot Below) with 2 tabs lets start with tab 1



Under Page Settings Select the Project, select the Number of Pages you want to Post and then how many minutes the time interval will be between the last and the next posting ( We recommend you post 3 pages from you website to your Blog every 15 minutes )

However you can choose your own settings anywhere from 1 page upwards  
Time intervals can start from 1 minute upwards

### **Body of Message**

You can choose between Description, Random Text or Unique to be posted to the blog from the page being posted

**Description** = Meta Tag Description of that Page being posted ( This only works if your pages have Description in code – go to VIEW Source Code to check if they do before choosing this ( great for sites where pages have different description on each page)


**Random Text** = Random text anywhere from 100 to 500 words taken from the page being posted ( Great for TE, Directory Generator, Nichemonster, Metawebs Sites)

**Unique TAGS** = If you choose this you have to type into the field beside it a tag that you want IBP to find in the source code of your pages for example you could type “StartContent” without the “” of course  
Then what you would have to do is go to a page that has content already ( this works best with regular sites NOT te sites) go to the page go into the HTML code and find some text you want to pull in. and type <StartContent> in front of it and then </StartContent> after the content section .. basically then it will pull in anything between those tags.  
Again this will only really work on CONTENT sites

LAST you can either SAVE at that point OR you can choose to use PROXY and save. BUT realize IT MUST BE VALID proxy and Fast or Your just going to encounter issues with posting.


## Posting Settings

OK When you click this Tab You will see a Screen like this ( screenshot Below)




Everything will be empty to start with, you will see the name of your project, then you need to click on the dropdown and pick yahoo or pingomatic or both and then insert your BLOG URL and click ADD and it will place it in front as seen

The Url to PING in my case would be <http://instantblogandping.blogspot.com/>  
It's the homepage url you see when you view your blog and posts  
See how this would look below inputted in




## BLOG AND PING – STEP 3 - BUTTON 3

Last step click on button 3 and you will see a window like this



Select from the drop down the project your working on and click OPEN that will then bring up a screen like this below



**Add From URL** – This is where you could add a website you want all the pages crawled and displayed – then click SHOW URLs button and it will crawl in all the pages from that site ready for posting and pinging

**Add from File** – If you have a txt file on your hardrive full of urls or domains you want to post you can click here and browse for it then click SHOW URLs and they will be displayed in the white area ready for posting and pinging

**Add URL** – If you wish to add one URL at a time, or Different URLs you can do that here by adding it in and then hitting SHOW URLs to display them ready for psoting and pinging.

**The White Area** Is both the area it shows Pages before they are posted to your blog and also a reporting area to show you them being posted and pinged.

**Show URLs** – Button to press after you add any website URL in one of the 3 fields

**Start** – The Button to Press to Start Posting to your Blog and Pinging

**Stop** – The Button to Press to Stop Posting

**Stop Crawling** – Stops crawling in pages ( useful on large sites where you don't want to wait)

**Save URLs as TXT file** – Use this if you wish to save the crawled in urls.. you can only do this when a site is FULLY crawled in. You would then at a later date come back and use the ADD from FILE to pull them in

The Other Buttons are for Selecting and Deleting Urls displayed

***Ok so if you have a website that is 1000 pages we recommend you use the first field “ Add from URL” put your homepage in their lets say for instance <http://www.mysite.com> then click SHOW URLs button depending on how big your site is, will determine how long you have to wait for it to pull in all your pages, the bigger the site, the longer the wait so be patient and give it time. Once its pulled them in it will display how many pages and list them all. It will also say in the status that its complete and the start button will be active to press***

***Next click START and then it will begin the process of Posting to your blog and Pinging depending on how slow the server responds is will determine how fast it posts, also what your internet connection speed is like.***

***At this point you can either minimize it and let it do its Automated Magic or You can go to FILE – Create New Project and start another project so that you have 2 projects blogging at once***

# Troubleshooting

## ***Multiple Project Issues***

Someone asked me a good question about HOW many projects can I run at one time with Instant Blog and Ping before it locks up or posting issues occur.

Well the Answer to that is AS many as your Computer can handle.. reason I say this is every computer is different, Computers can only handle SO many applications running at one time not matter what application it is.. larger applications like WORD, ADOBE, anything intensive will be harder on your computer and use more resources a computer fully tweaked can start up from a fresh boot at around 90% resources once you start opening applications your resources drop .. maybe to 50%.. now depending on how much RAM you have an how many applications you have open and how long you've had your computer on since last turning it off. Will determine how much it can handle..

Basically PUT every computer is different, I Used to work for DELL technical Support and I once had a question asked to me by a customer calling in.. He said My computer keeps locking up and some applications run slow and sometimes hang. I asked him how many applications he had open he said 8 I asked him what type of applications.. he mentioned ones that work HEAVY on the computer.. I said How much ram do you have.. he said 512.. I said.. well you have ONLY 2 options

1. Get more RAM and try that
2. Close some of your applications

He really couldn't comprehend why he should.. I said bottom line is YOU can force your computer to do more than he can handle without things slowing down, problems occurring..

So relating this to MULTIPLE PROJECTS your computer might only be able to handle 1 project at a time , some peoples 2, some 4.. You will need to find the threshold before you start to see problems.. if problems arise CUT back a project and only run 1 at a time. Or 2 at a time.

Also ask yourself when was the last time your turned off your computer?, or how many programs have you got starting up when your computer first starts up.. You would be surprised at how many people used to call in with about 20 applications that start up... IF you want to see how many applications are starting up do this...

Click on START BUTTON click on RUN type in the field

MSCONFIG and click ok

That will bring MSCONFIG up then click on the STARTUP tab.. everything checked is whats starting up in the background.. I bet your surprised at what is.... 😊

Don't uncheck everything unless you know EXACTLY what your doing.. otherwise you might BUGGER it up.. ( no I don't mean your computer will cease to function) I mean certain programs might REQUIRE to be in there.. You can always ask a computer rep and they can assist you..

## ***Crawling***

For the most part we have tested every type of site that possibly could be used to blog and ping.. but remember we cant test them all.. and secondly some sites are just BADLY BADLY put together meaning the navigation is terrible.. so if certain pages you know exist are not being pulled in.. please check that you have a clear path from your homepage to those pages.

## **POSTING**

Ok posting is a BIGGIE!! There are so many variables that come into play that can prevent posting from happening to name a few are

- = Blog Server Response time ( usually 20 seconds default)
- Internet Connection Speed ( Slower your speed, slower everything)
- PROXY – ( Unless you have a nice fresh supply of VALID fast proxies and a nice fast internet connection I wouldn't use this option)

Reason I say that is because.. If any of you have ever taken a proxy and placed it in browser settings and then tried to surf.. the result is usually SLOW SLOW page loading.. as the connection is not direct..... So if you experience more UNPOSTED.. check your proxy.. even remove your proxy..

For the most part we have seen out of 500 pages posted maybe only 2 or 3 pages not post and that's on cable connection.. there is some variables that are out of our control when it comes to servers responding and such..

PLEASE BE SURE aswell to always check to see if BLOGGER.com is even up.. I had some emails at one time that said no posting were happening I went to blogger.com and it said they were down.. ( that's why!)

- PINGING

Let me explain how this works.. if you setup to post 3 pages every 15 mins what it will do is post 3 pages Ping once and then wait 15 mins from the time of the 1<sup>st</sup> post and then it will start the next 3 pages and then wait 15 mins.. You will only ever see 1 ping per group of posting...

BLOG, How many sites per blog?

I was asked how many sites should a person mix on one blog account..? Well You can have several... but if I was you I would make them all on the same theme meaning if your doing cell phones.. make that blog completely about cell phones.. don't post website pages from toys or underpants

Personally myself I only ever use 1 site per 1 blog account.. this way I have NEVER had any of my blogs banned, or any of my sites taken out of the index

Which brings me to the next thing I have heard.... Online Some people have said.. Oh my sites were indexed and then they were pulled.. Has blog and ping method stopped working?

NO,NO, no..... I saw people post these sites on forums online for people to look.. and ILL tell you why they got DE-INDEXED.. because they were complete CRAP.. what I mean by that is.. there was no effort gone into them to make them look original or to basically make them unique.. it was just spam city.. Now at best directory websites like TE, Directory Generator, Nichemonster, Metawebs can be horrible looking sites.. BUT the ones that stay indexed are usually the ones where the person has been creative.. took a little bit more effort creating and disguising. So be creative!!!. Don't go mad spitting out sites like there is no tomorrow.. do one really well then move on to the next..


## WordPress BLOG Users
